What is SEE?

- It is a service designed to assist students who have an intellectual disability find and maintain Summer Employment.
- The student is provided with Job Readiness Training and Orientation Training.
- A Job Coach is provided to all students in the program.

How the Summer Employment Experience Works....

- Students ages 16-29 years, in school and returning to school.
- Students with a disability who have a SIN #.
- 7 week paid summer job.
- 4 hours-25 hours a week for 7 weeks between July and August.
- Minimum wage or more.
